## The Importance of Certified VSO's: more than parades, flags, and ceremonies

- 1. take **all** applications for benefits
- 2. maintain discharge &service records; safeguard the names of clients
- 3. Funerals, burials, cemeteries
- 4. Outreach services
  - 1. referrals and assistance about available benefits and services
  - 2. work with federal, state, and local governmental bodies and agencies, as well as private entities, as needed
- 5. Conduct public information campaigns to ensure that the eligible population is aware of current laws
- 6. Keep current with changes in the laws which affect veterans' benefits and services by attending professional development programs and by communicating with DVS
- 7. Ceremonial duties
