


## **SREC Program is Part**of Mass. Portfolio Standard

### \*What is it?

- \* Statutory construct
- \* Promotes renewable energy
- \* Supplier purchase requirement

#### TWO STANDARDS




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- \* RPS split into two classes:
  - \* Class I: Post-1997 facilities
  - \* Class II: Pre-1998 facilities
- \* Eligible fuel includes solar PV, wind, landfill gas, anaerobic digestion, etc.
- \* Note: Waste Energy included in Class II

- \* What does this all mean?
  - \* Suppliers must purchase electricity from energy sources in each standard/class—RPS I, RPS II, APS. . . .

## "Solar Carve Out" (2008)

#### **RPS Class I: Includes Solar Carve Out**



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## Complying with RPS

- \*How do utilities/suppliers comply?
  - \*Own eligible generator,
  - \*Buy from eligible generator, or
  - \*Buy RECs/SRECs/WECs/AECs

# Why should you care about SRECs?

- \*Project viability
- \* Three legged revenue stool:
  - \* SRECs
  - \* Net Metering Credits
  - \* Federal benefits

Will SREC II adversely affect project economics and potential for municipal (NMC) savings?

### \* It depends:

- \* SREC II = fewer SRECs/MWh
- \* Will demand exceed supply?
- \* State massages supply/demand
- \* SREC incentive intended to decline

- \* Net Metering Credits:
  - \* NMC caps being met
  - \* Will they be increased?
- \* Federal tax credits set to expire

- \*Any savings is good?
  - \* Maybe not
  - \* Look at risk as well as savings
  - \* Less savings = less value for risk:
    - \* Less margin for fluctuating NMC
    - \*20 year contract

# Procurement Refresher (Third-Party Owned Facilities)

- \* On municipal (open) land:
  - \* G.L. c. 30B, s. 16 (RFP), or
  - \* G.L. c. 25A, ss. 11C (RFP)/11I (RFQ)
- \* On municipal building:
  - \* G.L. c. 25A, ss. 11C/11I
- \* NMCPA: 30B-exempt energy contract

## **Contracting Traps for the Unwary**

- \* Understand NMC value.
- \* Will facility qualify as NMF of Muni?
- \* Will you need to remove panels?
- \* What if facility is not finished/removed?
- \* Understand assignment to SPE.
- \* Understand liquidated damages.
- \* Can you terminate early?
