*Neighborhood Stabilization in this context is defined as actions that improve health and safety conditions of substandard and vacant properties; stabilize market conditions, foster increased homeownership, and encourage upgrades to existing properties.

Create a neighborhood stabilization initiative to assist local governments and their nonprofit partners to implement strategic neighborhood revitalization initiatives; focus on identifying and implementing strategies for reclaiming vacant, abandoned and blighted properties and restoring them to productive use as homeownership opportunities or rental housing, as well as on capacity-building at the local level to address this need.
