How To Enjoy Being An Effective Board/Council

- 1. Choose a strong chair or president.
- 2. Have a full board/council orientation session after each election including how members are going treat each other, working through conflict for the common good, etc.
- 3. Adopt a "Code of Conduct" so everyone knows the expectation of how to deal with each other, the staff and the public.
- 4. Read a brief statement at the start of each meeting how everyone at the meeting is expected to act.
- 5. Annual goal setting meeting including a reminder to all about the Code of Conduct.
- 6. Take a breath. Do you really need to be part of every conversion?
- 7. Is this issue a one or a ten? Keep things in perspective. Your community has been around for hundreds of years and faced difficult issues along the way.
- 8. You can't keep everyone happy but you can vote to do what you believe is in the best interest of the community.
