


Legislation (2 year cycle)

State Budget Process (1 year cycle)



Roads, bridges, culverts

- ☐ Increase Chapter 90 to \$300 million
- Maintain winter road funding
- ☐ Increase funding for Small Town Road Assistance Program (STRAP) via MassWorks (via Community One Stop)
- More \$\$ for small bridge program and expand availability

Water and sewer

- Expand funding for MVP to include water and sewer
 - □ \$200M for environmental infrastructure
- □ Solidify funding for PFAS testing, mitigation, research
- Ban PFAS from the Commonwealth

Municipal and public safety buildings

- □ S.2457/H.3821 An Act Creating a municipal public safety building authority
 - Extended to May 5 in Joint Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security
- Independent authority + matching funds (up to \$1M)

Green and healthy public schools

- \$100M in ARPA spending in play via DESE
- S.1382 An Act for healthy and green public schools
 - □ Assess, create standards, make recommendations

PILOT

- ☐ State-owned land is public infrastructure
- Need to increase state-owned land PILOT funding to \$45M
- Need to change PILOT formula which has disadvantaged WMA municipalities

Regional rail

- ☐ Four initiatives:
 - West/East
 - Valley Flyer (ongoing and successful pilot)
 - Berkshire Flyer (launching June 2022)
 - Northern Tier (study process kicked off)
- Federal and state efforts on governance and funding

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
