

Food Security

- An Act Relative to Universal School Meals (H714/S314)
- Universal School Meals (7053-1925) \$110m in House Budget





Early Education

- An Act Providing For Universal Pre-K For 3- To 5-Year-Olds (H701)
- An Act to Expand Access to High-Quality, Affordable Early Education and Care (H4795/S2883)
- C3 Stabilization Grant (3000-1045) \$250m in Senate Budget





Housing

- An Act to guarantee a tenant's first right of refusal (TOPA) (H1426)
- An Act relative to housing production (H1448/S871)
- An Act relative to the establishment of a means tested senior citizen property tax exemption (H2915) & An Act creating a local option property tax cap for low-income seniors (H3055)





Transportation


- An Act relative to Massachusetts's transportation resources and climate (H4897)
- Regional Transit Authority Funding (1595-6370) - \$94m in House Budget, \$96.5m in Senate Budget





Behavioral Health

 An Act addressing barriers to care for mental health (H4879)

Access To State Services

- An Act to Lift Kids Out of Deep Poverty (H199/S96)
- An Act to Streamline Access to Critical Public Health and Safety-Net Programs Through Common Applications (H1290/S761)
- An Act Concerning Public Assistance for Working Families and the Creation of a Pilot Program to Address the Impacts of the Cliff Effect (H208/S119)
