## **Guidelines for MMCA Board Members**

- 1. Regular attendance at MMA Board Meetings, and LGAC meetings (appointed members).
- 2. Regular attendance at monthly MMCA Board meetings.
- 3. Attendance at MMCA webinars, trainings, meetings. These include virtual and in-person events. It's important for board members to support the work of the association and contribute to the presentation through questions or additional information.
- 4. Participate in the development and execution of member events. This includes contributing program ideas, outreach to identified speakers, moderating sessions, or speaking when appropriate.
- 5. The President and First Vice President serve on the MMA Executive Committee, which meets periodically throughout the year. Other additional duties may be assigned to these positions.
- 6. The First Vice President provides support to the President and can be expected to assume that role if needed. For example, leading a board or membership meeting.
- 7. If you cannot attend a scheduled meeting, communicate this with MMA staff and/or the MMCA President.
- 8. If you find that you are not able to participate during your tenure, after discussion with the President and consideration, you will step down from your position.
